


NATURE TRAILS

on the nature trail. All of the spiders you'll see,

including the huge golden orb weaver, are harmless

and help to keep mosquitoes under control.

- Stay on the path.
- No smoking on the nature trail.
- Properly dispose of trash in the available receptacles.
- Leave the trail as you found it.
- Be respectful of local wildlife as you are a visitor in their habitat.
- In the event of inclement weather, please exit trail immediately.
- Do not remove plants or wildlife.
